1. Mr. Raj Singh Phogat, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the challenge is to the impugned order dated February 2, 2024 whereby the respondent Nos.1 and 2 have rejected the request of the petitioner for grant of NOC to him to join employment outside the Indian Coast Guard only on the ground that the petitioner is under probation.
2. Mr. Phogat states that if the Officer is under probation there is more reason that the respondents to grant NOC to enable the petitioner join the employment outside the Indian Coast Guard.
