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1. Having perused the contents of the plaint and having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the following issues are framed:-

- i. *Whether the plaintiff and the defendant are entitled to equal shares of suit schedule properties as averred by the defendant or 2/3rd to the plaintiff and 1/3rd to the defendant as averred by the plaintiff? **Onus of proof on the parties***
- ii. *Manner in which the Schedule-I property can be best divided amongst the parties in the ratio determined in answer to issue no.1? **Onus of proof on the parties***
- iii. *Whether the properties mentioned in Part 'C' of Schedule III of the plaint - jewellery worth Rs. 8.00 Lakh and FDRs worth Rs.18.00 Lakh in the name of the defendant are self-acquired personal and private properties of the defendant and not required to be shared with the plaintiff? **OPD***
- iv. *Whether the suit is not properly valued for the purpose of payment of Court Fee? **OPD***



v. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the injunctions as sought? **OPP**

vi. Relief.

2. The parties shall file their respective list of witnesses within a period of four weeks.
3. The plaintiff shall file affidavit by way of evidence of his witnesses within the same period.
4. List before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 12th May, 2023.
