1. The hearing has been conducted through Video Conferencing.
2. The Department of Education has filed a status report vide index No.138340/22. During the course of submissions, it was suggested that the Department of Education be asked as if they are inclined to take over the management of the Respondent No.1-School. Learned counsel for Department of Education has referred to Paragraph-7(a) of the said status report wherein it is stated that it is the policy matter and the higher authorities should take a decision in terms of the Act and Rules. The learned counsel for the respondents No.3 to 5 shall file an affidavit in this regard.
3. It is not possible to hear the matter today, as pagination of the paperbook has not been done. The Registry is directed to paginate the case file of the petition before the next date of hearing.



4. Affidavit of assets of respondent No.1- School be also filed and placed on record before the next date of hearing.
5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the respondent No.1-School that the respondent No.1-School is being run by Arya Samaj, Tilak Nagar, details of which shall be furnished by learned counsel for the respondent No.1-School before the next date of hearing.
6. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.2 is the society which runs the respondent No.1-School, which fact is disputed by the learned counsel for the respondent No.1-School.
7. An affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing as to who is running the respondent No.1-School. Such an affidavit shall be filed not only by respondent No.1-School but also by the respondents No.3 to 5 along with supporting evidence.
8. Learned counsel for the petitioner as also learned counsel for the respondent No.1-School intend to file response to the status report filed by the respondents No.3 to 5. Let the same be filed and placed on record by them before the next date of hearing with advance copies thereof to each other.
