ORDER

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1. Pursuant to the last order, the Manager of the respondent no.1/school is present in Court and submits that since all the students have already left the school, no activity of any kind, whatsoever is being undertaken in the school and the building has also been taken over by the Arya Samaj, which had permitted the school to run from the building without charging any rent. He further submits that the school does not have any funds to pay any further amount to the petitioners, who have already been paid their full salaries till March, 2020.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case the respondent no.1 is not in a position to clear the outstanding dues of the petitioners, the respondent no.2/Society, which has been running the school, should pay the outstanding dues of the petitioners.
3. The record shows that bailable warrants directed to be issued to the



respondent no.2 could not be executed as it was found that the name and address of the Society was not correctly mentioned.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for and is granted time to move an appropriate application in this regard.

6. The Manager of the respondent no.1 will remain present in Court on the next date.
