2. No reply to the captioned IAs have been filed.

3. Pleadings be completed as per law.

4. Learned counsel for defendant no.1 to 9 had already submitted that he does not wish to file reply to the captioned IA and he has no objection, if defendant no.7 is appointed as guardian-ad-litem for defendant no.9.
5. The captioned IA is listed for consideration before the Hon'ble Court on 20/09/2022.

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6. Written statement, documents and affidavit of admission/denial of documents of defendant no.1 to 9 is on record. Replication to written statement of defendant no.1 to 9, documents and affidavit of admission/denial of documents of plaintiff is on record.

12. Parties are at liberty to produce the original/certified copies of the documents on the next date of hearing for the purpose of admission/denial of documents.
13. The matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court on date already fixed i.e. **20th September, 2022** for further directions.
