1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the applicant/plaintiff seeking a direction to the State Bank of India, Defence Colony Branch, New Delhi and the Union Bank of India, Kailash Colony Branch, New Delhi to not transfer any further interest amount in respect of the four fixed deposits (FDs) bearing Nos.30604438537 and 30604438741 at the State Bank of India and Nos.355703021012609 and 355703021010672 at the Union Bank of India to the parties.
2. This Court vide order dated 30th October, 2019 had directed that the interest from the aforesaid FDs shall be credited to the account of the mother of the plaintiff and defendant No.1, who was the defendant No.2 in the present suit.



3. It is stated that the defendant No.2 expired on 15th January, 2022, leaving behind the plaintiff and defendant No.1 as her only legal heirs. Therefore, the order dated 30th October, 2019 passed by this Court is liable to be modified.

4. Issue notice.

5. Notice be issued to the defendant No.1 through counsel.

6. Till the next date of hearing, the aforesaid banks are directed to not transfer any further interest in respect of the aforesaid FDs to the account No.159810755431 of the defendant No.2, Late Smt. Chander Malhotra, with IndusInd Bank, Palm Springs Plaza, Gurgaon.
