1. None appears for Respondent No.1.
2. On steps being taken, let fresh Notice be issued to the Respondent No.1 via all modes. An affidavit of service be filed within a week.
3. The decretal amount as directed by this Court has not been deposited.
4. Quite clearly, the order dated 25.04.2024 was passed staying the operation of the Impugned Judgment, subject to the deposit of the decretal amount which has not been deposited till today.
5. However, in the interest of justice, eights weeks' additional time is granted to the Appellant to deposit the decretal amount. It is made clear that if the decretal amount is not deposited, the interim protection granted by the Court shall automatically stand dissolved.
6. List before the concerned Registrar for completion of service on 06.02.2025.
7. Learned Counsel for the Appellant submits that the issue as is obtaining in the present Appeal also obtains in LA. APP. 138/2018 captioned ***Chander Bhan (Decd) Thr. LRs v. Union of India & Ors.*** which



stands admitted before the Court.
