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17.09.2024

1. This petition has been filed by the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking reliefs after a delay of nearly five decades.
2. When the petition was listed for admission on 25.04.2024, the Court noted that instead of dismissing the petition in *limine* on delay and laches, an opportunity must be given to the Petitioner to explain the inordinate delay.
3. On 23.07.2024, adjournment was sought on behalf of the Petitioner on the ground that the counsel was unwell and the matter was adjourned for 09.08.2024, on which date again a request for adjournment was made by the Petitioner and the matter was adjourned for today.
4. This is the second call in the matter *albeit* an affidavit has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, there is no appearance on behalf of the Petitioner.
5. It appears that the Petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the petition which is evident from the earlier order sheets.

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6. Accordingly, petition is dismissed for non-prosecution and default.
Pending application also stands disposed of.
