CM APPL. 53465/2024 (condonation of delay)

This is an application filed by respondent no. 6 under section 151 CPC for condonation of delay of 95 days in filing the counter affidavit.

A perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 04.03.2024, it was directed as under:

“Learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 1 to 4 and 6 seeks and is granted four weeks’ time to file counter affidavit, as a last opportunity, failing which the Registry shall not take the counter affidavit till the permission is sought from this Court. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter.”
