1. By this application the appellant seeks interim suspension of sentence on the ground that he has to arrange the marriage of his youngest daughter.
2. A status report has been filed verifying the fact that the appellant has three daughters. The two elder-ones have already been married and are residing somewhere in Bihar. The youngest daughter Varsha who is present in Court also is residing in Delhi and it is her marriage which is to be performed.
3. Varsha who is present in Court states that she is doing work at Laxmi Nagar and thus residing in Delhi at a rented accommodation and once her father comes out he would be in a position to finalize her marriage.
4. A perusal of the nominal roll of the appellant would reveal that the appellant was granted interim bail during the pendency of trial and there is no allegation that the appellant misused the said concession.



5. Considering the facts verified this Court deems it fit to grant interim suspension of sentence to the appellant. It is therefore directed that the appellant be released on interim suspension of sentence for a period of four weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹20,000/- with one surety bond of the like amount which surety would be a family member of the appellant preferably his own daughter to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court/ CMM/ Duty Magistrate, further subject to the condition that the appellant would inform the mobile phone number on which he can be contacted during the period of interim suspension of sentence when the said mobile phone will be kept in active mode.

6. Application is disposed of.
