CRL.M.(BAIL) 213/2023 (Interim suspension of sentence)

The present application has been instituted on behalf of the appellant under Section 389 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying as follows:

- i. The sentence of the Appellant/Applicant may kindly be suspended for a period of 4 (four) weeks and he be released on interim bail; and/or
- ii. Any other order or direction may kindly be passed which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts of the case."

We have perused the medical report dated 10.03.2023 filed by the Superintendent of Prison, Central Jail No. 11, Mandoli, Delhi and observed that the applicant/appellant is currently stable with no further



need for any emergency treatment. It is further observed that the vitals are in the normal limits and the applicant/appellant is opined to be stable.

In view of the foregoing, the present application seeking interim suspension of sentence on medical grounds, is dismissed.

However, the jail authorities are directed to ensure that the applicant/appellant receives the low residue diet as in terms of the advise given by the Guru Teg Bahadur Hospital, Dilshad Garden, Delhi while discharging him.

The present application is dismissed and disposed of accordingly.
