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1. The learned counsels for the parties submit that though the earlier attempt to settle their disputes could not fructify, they are hopeful that if the parties are again referred to the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, they may be able to arrive at an amicable settlement. 2. The parties shall appear before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 16.01.2023 at 4.00 p.m..
3. The Mediation Centre is requested to appoint the same Mediator who had earlier made an attempt that the parties arrive at an amicable settlement.
4. The Mediator shall allow the Trustees of the plaintiff-Trust in CS(OS) 339/2022 to appear virtually before him/her.
5. List before the Court on 6th March, 2023.
6. The interim arrangement made earlier shall continue.
