1. This application has been filed for early hearing in the matter. The matter is already listed on 20th May 2025.
2. Counsel for petitioner states that, as per them, the respondents' no.1-5 are attempting to sell the properties.
3. It has been made clear that if any alienation is made contrary to the statements given before the *Civil Judge-01, South, Saket, New Delhi* on 29th July 2019, then such action shall amount to contempt of the Court's order, and the respondent will have to be committed to contempt proceedings.
4. Also, if any purchase of the property which has been sold in violation of the undertaking given to the Court, shall risk the said transfer/sale being



void.

5. Counsel for petitioner is at liberty to communicate this order to the respondents.

6. Counsel for petitioner also states that the water supply has been cut off in violation of the undertaking already given.

7. It has also been made clear that any complaint to this effect by petitioner shall be looked into by the authorities immediately, so that the supply of utility is not cut off, considering an undertaking was given by the respondents in this regard.

8. These directions have been passed on the basis of the submissions which have been made by the counsel for petitioner.

9. Application stands disposed of, accordingly.
