ORDER

23.01.2023

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1. As per the previous order of this court dated 4th January 2023, the state was to verify the facts stated in the application filed for seeking interim bail by the appellant regarding the appellant's new born baby whose function was scheduled for 31st January, 2023.
2. As per the status report which has been filed, it is verified that the appellant has only one son Rehan who is one year old and his birthday is to be celebrated on 31st January, 2023.
3. The prosecutrix is also present in the Court and states that while they stay in Uttam Nagar, from a perusal of the record of the Court and the application it is stated by the appellant that on his release of interim bail he would be going to his native village in Bagoch PS Kuchah Kot District,



Gopal Ganj, Bihar for attending the function for his little son.

4. Considering the facts have been verified, this Court deems it fit to grant interim suspension of sentence to the appellant. Consequently, the sentence of the appellant is suspended for a period of 20 days from the date of release on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000/- with one surety bond of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court/CMM/Duty Magistrate further subject to the following conditions:

- i. Appellant will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
 - ii. Appellant shall provide permanent address to the Ld. Trial Court. The appellant shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the IO regarding any change in residential address.
 - iii. Appellant shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing.
 - iv. Appellant shall provide all mobile numbers to the IO concerned which shall be kept in working condition at all times and shall not switch off or change the mobile number without prior intimation to the IO concerned. The mobile location be kept on at all times.
 - v. Appellant shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with the complainant/victim or any member of the complainant/victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case.
5. Copy of the order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
6. Accordingly, the application is disposed of.
