This hearing has been held by video conferencing.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two cheques which were given by the respondent to the petitioner have been returned by the bank with the remarks 'insufficient funds'.

The learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent has prayed for further extension of time to make this payment.

It is noted that the present Contempt Petition itself has been filed due to disobedience of the order dated 13.08.2019 of this Court by which the Settlement Agreement between the parties was taken on record. The Settlement Agreement required the respondent to pay an amount of Rs.8 lacs to the petitioner on or before 13.11.2019 and, thereafter, pay the balance of Rs.92 lacs in four equal instalments of Rs.23 lacs every six months.

The petitioner has alleged that the respondent has paid only a cash amount of Rs.80,000/- and that too on 18.09.2020.

I think that the respondent is clearly acting in a contemptuous manner. Accordingly, the respondent shall appear in person before this Court in



person on 10.11.2020, which is the physical hearing day of this Court.

The respondent shall show cause as to why he be not proceeded with for having committed contempt of this Court. Such show cause be filed on or before 6th November, 2020.
