1. This application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff seeking leave of the Court to place on record the additional documents.
2. To be noted, the additional documents, which are described in para 4 of the application, were filed by the plaintiff on 9th February, 2024.
3. Ms Prachi Aggarwal, counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff submits that the present application has been filed pursuant to an objection taken by the defendant that these documents have been filed without leave of the Court.
4. Issue Notice.
5. Mr Apoorva Murali, advocate accepts notice on behalf of the defendant.
6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.



7. In my considered view, taking into account that these are documents which came into existence after the admission/denial of documents had already taken place and are necessary for the proper adjudication of the suit, the same ought to be taken on record.

7.1 It is ordered accordingly.

8. However, this is without prejudice to the rights of the defendant to object to the relevancy as well as the admissibility of the aforesaid documents.

9. Further, the defendant is given liberty to place additional documents in rebuttal to the aforesaid documents, within a period of two (2) weeks from today.

10. Application stands disposed of.

11. In view of the additional documents being taken on record, affidavit of admission/denial of documents in respect of the additional documents may be filed within four (4) weeks from today.

12. List before the learned Joint Registrar on the date fixed i.e., 5th December 2024 for conducting admission/denial of documents filed on behalf of the plaintiff as well as admission/denial of documents that may be filed on behalf of defendant in rebuttal.

13. List before Court on the date fixed i.e., 22nd January, 2025.

14. In light of the order passed above, plaintiff may request the learned Joint Registrar for additional time to file evidence by way of affidavit of its witnesses.
