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The admission/denial has already been completed on 06.12.2023 in the main suit.

CC (COMM) - 7/2024

The plaintiff has filed the written statement to the counter claim, vide diary no. 717019/24. The counsel for the defendant no.1/counter claimant states that the written statement has been filed with a delay of 11 days. She submits that the Hon'ble Court on 09.02.2024 had directed the plaintiff to file the written statement within 30 days, which as per the office notings was filed on 41st day i.e. on 21.03.2024. The counsel for the plaintiff orally prays for the condonation of this miniscule delay. The counsel for the respondent no. 1 on the other hand states the costs must be imposed before permitting the condonation.
