CRL.M. (BAIL) 33/2023 (Regular Bail)

The present application under Section 389 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, has been instituted on behalf of Manoj Shah *alias* Raj Kumar *alias* Raj, the applicant/appellant seeking regular suspension of sentence and grant of bail during the pendency of the appeal.

Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties, we are of the considered view that, no good grounds for grant of regular suspension of sentence during the pendency of the appeal, are made out.

In view of the foregoing, the present application seeking regular suspension of sentence during the pendency of the appeal, is dismissed



whilst reserving liberty to the applicant/appellant to revive the same, in the event, the appeals are not heard within a reasonable period of time.

The application is disposed of accordingly.

CRL.A. 404/2020

In view of the circumstance that Manoj Shah *alias* Raj Kumar *alias* Raj, the appellant *herein*, is stated to have undergone incarceration for more than nine years, we are inclined to take the present appeal itself, along with the connected appeals, up for hearing, on an early date.
