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CM APPL. 10881/2022 in RFA 459/2019

1. The present application has been filed under Order I Rule 10 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (“CPC”), on behalf of the appellant, for amendment of the name of respondent and impleadment of proposed respondent no. 2.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits that the suit was partially decreed in favour of the appellant. It is submitted that the appellant in the month of August, 2019 has learnt that the respondent, i.e., M/s IL&FS Education & Technology Services Limited, was renamed as Schoolnet India Ltd.
3. She further submits that it has also come to the knowledge of the appellant that Schoolnet India Ltd., was taken over/sold to M/s Falafal Technology Pvt. Ltd., i.e., subsidiary of proposed respondent nos. 2 M/s Lexington Equity Holdings Ltd. along with all its assets and liabilities, as stated in order dated 31st August, 2020, passed by the NCLT-I, Mumbai Bench.
4. Thus, the present application has been filed for impleadment of M/s Falafal Technology Pvt. Ltd., and M/s Lexington Equity Holdings Ltd., as respondents in the present appeal.
5. *Per contra*, learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that though the name of the respondent has been changed to Schoolnet India Ltd., however, he submits that M/s Falafal Technology Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Lexington Equity Holdings Ltd., are only shareholders in the said company to the extent of 73.90%.
6. Considering the submissions made before this Court, it is directed that the name of the respondent in *RFA 459/2019*, shall be substituted as



Schoolnet India Ltd.

7. Let Amended Memo of Parties be filed within a period of one week, from today, showing the said changes.

8. As regards the submission of the appellant with reference to securing the interest of appellant, i.e., Mr. Rajiv Aggarwal, it is clarified that any decree in favour of Mr. Rajiv Aggarwal, shall be duly complied with by the Schoolnet India Ltd., or any entity having rights over its assets and liabilities.

9. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is disposed of.

CM APPL. 43112/2023 in RFA 771/2019

10. The present application has been filed on behalf of the appellant, i.e., M/s IL&FS Education & Technology Services Limited, for placing on record the documents concerning the current changed name, i.e., Schoolnet India Ltd.

11. Considering the submissions made before this Court, the present application is allowed and the name of the M/s IL&FS Education & Technology Services Limited, is allowed to be substituted with Schoolnet India Ltd.

12. The Amended Memo of Parties filed along with the present application, is taken on record.

13. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is disposed of.

RFA 459/2019 & RFA 771/2019

14. On account of the name change of the company, i.e., M/s IL&FS Education & Technology Services Limited to Schoolnet India Ltd., the Registry of this Court is directed to effect the change in the cause list of this Court in terms of the Amended Memo of Parties.



15. Trial Court Record in the present matter has already been received.
16. Accordingly, both the parties are directed to file their written submissions, along with the judgments that they wish to rely upon, before the next date of hearing.
