The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the 'BNSS'), seeking quashing of FIR No. 432/2018 registered at Police Station K.N. Katju Marg for the offences punishable under Sections 354D/509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter referred to as the 'IPC'), as well as the order on charge dated 30.07.2024 and the consequential proceedings pending before the learned JMFC (Mahila Court), Rohini Courts, Delhi, wherein charges have been framed under Sections 354A/509 IPC.
