1. This application is filed jointly on behalf of the Plaintiff and Defendant No. 2 under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC for recording of settlement between parties.

2. This suit was instituted on behalf of the Plaintiff *inter alia* seeking a decree of permanent injunction restraining the Defendants and all others acting on their behalf from manufacturing, offering for sale, selling, displaying, advertising, marketing, whether directly or indirectly and whether on the internet or otherwise, ointments and any other medicinal or pharmaceutical products bearing Defendants' KBACT mark and marks that incorporate Defendants' KBACT mark such as KBACT-CM mark or any other mark that is nearly identical/deceptively similar to Plaintiff's T-BACT



mark, amounting to infringement and/or passing off.

3. During the pendency of the suit, Plaintiff and Defendant No. 2 have amicably resolved their *inter se* disputes and the terms of settlement are incorporated in paragraph 2 of the application.

4. Court has perused the terms of settlement and finds the same to be lawful. Accordingly, this application is allowed and disposed of, recording the settlement between Plaintiff and Defendant No. 2.

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5. In light of settlement between the Plaintiff and Defendant No. 2, the suit is decreed in favour of the Plaintiff *qua* Defendant No. 2. Terms of settlement shall form a part of the decree and needless to state bind the parties thereto.
