1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:

“A. Directing the Respondent No. 1 to provide the Petitioner with hostel accommodation for the remainder of the LL.M. course;

B. Consequent to Prayer (A), directing the Respondent No. 1 to extend the Petitioner’s hostel accommodation proportionately in case his program is extended or he is enrolled in any other course at the Respondent No. 1 University;

C. Directing Respondent No. 1 to undertake an accessibility audit of its website by a government-empanelled web accessibility auditor and to comply with the findings of the audit within a time-bound manner, as fixed by this Hon’ble Court;

D. Directing Respondent No. 1 to ensure that its website remains disabled friendly during the lifetime of its operation”
