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1. Despite last opportunity, no counter affidavit has been filed by the respondent no.2 and therefore, in terms of the last order, right of the respondent no.2 to file counter affidavit stands closed.
2. At this stage, learned counsel for respondent no.2 submits that instead of a counter affidavit he had filed a status report under a *bonafide* impression that instead of filing a counter affidavit, he could file a status report. He submits that the status report filed by him has been returned under objection. He, therefore, prays for further time to file a status report.
3. Even though this Court is unable to appreciate this stand taken by the learned counsel for respondent no.2, in the interest of justice, the respondent no.2 is granted two weeks' time to file counter affidavit.
