4. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking the following reliefs:

“A. Allow the present petition;

B. Set-aside the proceedings in Contempt Petition No. 31 of 2022 titled as “Anand Tyagi vs. Devender Nath Sood & Anr.” pending before the Court of Ld. Civil Judge-06, Central District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi to the extent of passing of all supplementary and incidental directions which are not to be found in the original judgment/order dated 04.07.2005 of which contempt has been alleged;



C. Declare all supplementary and incidental directions passed by the Court of Ld. Civil Judge-06, Central District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi in Contempt Petition No. 31 of 2022 titled as “Anand Tyagi vs. Devender Nath Sood & Anr.” as non-est and bad in law;

D. Direct the Ld. Trial Court to finally decide the Contempt Petition in view of the settled position of law without being influenced by all the supplementary and incidental directions passed by the Ld. Court in the said proceedings;”

5. Upon the petitioner taking necessary steps, let notice be issued to the respondent through all permissible modes.
