ORDER

1. Mr. Pardeep Gupta, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the operative part of the order dated 22.01.2020, the contempt of which has been alleged in the present petition, specifically says that the petitioner should be regularized within a period of eight weeks and the service between 01.06.1998 and 31.12.2013, which was rendered by the petitioner with the respondent/department, shall be taken into account for the purposes of calculating pensionary benefits incidental to regular employment.

2. He further submits that though the petitioner was regularized with effect from 01.06.1998 and the appointment letter also mentions that the period of service rendered by the petitioner between 01.06.1998 and



31.12.2013 will be taken into account for the purposes of calculating pensionary benefits incidental to regular employment, but the petitioner has not been paid salary from the date of expiry of eight weeks time from the order dated 22.01.2020 till 17.08.2021.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent no.1 prays for time to seek instructions with regard to payment of salary for the said period to the petitioner.

4. Let needful be done before the next date.

5. Re-notify on 21.05.2025.
