CRL.M.A. 12527/2025 (Exemption)

1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 2805/2025 & CRL.M.A. 12526/2025 (Stay)

3. The present petition is filed challenging the order dated 21.01.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge ('ASJ') in CA No. 34/2024.
4. The learned ASJ, taking note of the conduct of the authorised representative of the petitioner, issued Non-Bailable Warrants and directed the Trial Court to proceed with the coercive steps against the petitioner.
5. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the authorised representatives of the petitioner inadvertently appeared through video-conference being unaware of the procedures.
6. He, on instructions, submits that henceforth, the authorised representatives will appear in person unless exempted by the Court.



7. He submits that the petitioner, in order to show its *bona fide*, will also deposit an amount of ₹3,00,000/- before the learned Appellate Court.
8. Issue notice.
9. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State accepts notice.
10. Issue notice to Respondent No.2 through all permissible modes, returnable on the next date of hearing.
11. On the petitioner depositing a sum of ₹3,00,000/- before the learned Appellate Court within a period of six weeks, the operation of the order dated 21.01.2025 is stayed till the next date of hearing.
