1. Learned counsel for respondents seek further time to file counter affidavits. Counter affidavits be filed within four weeks. Rejoinders thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
2. Mr. Ashwini Chawla, learned counsel for respondent no. 4/Yes Bank Ltd. submits that after receipt of the order dated 31.08.2020, Yes Bank has addressed letters to respondent nos. 5 and 6 in terms of the directions contained in paragraph 3 of the said order. He will place the said letters on record alongwith his counter affidavit. He will also place



on record the status of the accounts of respondent nos. 5 and 6, including the amounts lying to the credit of those accounts, at the moment.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent nos. 5 and 6 submit that the interim order contained in paragraph 3 of the order dated 31.08.2020 is affecting the said respondents adversely. He further submits that respondent nos. 5 and 6 have filed an application for vacation of the said order. I notice that despite the fact that notice was issued in this petition on 31.08.2020, respondent nos. 5 and 6 have not yet filed their affidavits. The application for vacation of the order is also not on record. The application will be considered at its own merits as and when it comes up for hearing.
