ORDER

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30.04.2024

1. The present petition has been filed alleging willful disobedience of specific directions issued vide order dated 20th February, 2024 in W.P.(C) No. 13450/2023, wherein it was categorically held that there was no infirmity in the order dated 18th March, 2023 passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal ("CAT"), Principal Bench, New Delhi in O.A. No. 25879/2021.



2. Thus, the respondent had been granted six weeks' time to implement the order passed by the learned CAT, wherein it had been, *inter-alia*, held that the petitioner's pay fixation order dated 29th August, 2019, consequent upon grant of the third MACP ("Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme"), was correct.
3. Thus, the respondents were directed to release all terminal benefits that were due to the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has still not received the requisite amounts.
5. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for the respondents.
6. Learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent no. 5 submits that the compliance has to be done by respondent nos. 1 to 4.
7. Learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 1 to 4 submits that he may be granted some time to file compliance affidavit.
8. Accordingly, compliance affidavit be filed by the respondent nos. 1 to 4 within a period of four weeks.
9. Re-notify on 30th July, 2024.
