1. Ms. Deeksha L. Kakar, learned counsel enters appearance for the newly impleaded party respondent / DDA. She submits that she has been instructed by the concerned official yesterday. She seeks and is granted four weeks time to file the counter affidavit in respect of the present petition. Rejoinder thereto be filed within two weeks thereafter.

2. Ms. Sarita Pandey, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.1/SDM Mehrauli submits that post notification there is no role remaining with the Revenue Authority insofar as the



present lis is concerned. She submits that accordingly the SDM/Mehrauli may be deleted from the array of parties.

3. There is no objection to such prayer by the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner as also by the other respondents. The SDM, Mehrauli is deleted as respondent no.1 from the array of parties subject, however, to the SDM, who is the custodian of the revenue records pertaining to the khasra numbers subject matter of the present petitioner, transferring the records to the DDA within a period of four weeks. The said copies shall also be filed within the same timeline before this Court.

4. Ms. Maan, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.2 undertakes to furnish a copy of the counter affidavit to learned counsel appearing for the petitioner within two days against the proper acknowledgment.
