ORDER

30.04.2024

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1. The Delhi High Court Bar Association has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“a. Issue direction, order or writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to take immediate steps, in a time bound manner, to provide additional space for infrastructural requirement and expansion of the Delhi high court including Delhi High Court Bar Association with regard to court rooms, lawyers chambers, parking space, record room facilities and other allied activities by redevelopment of adjacent



land at Bapa Nagar, Zakir Hussain Road, New Delhi, which has old existing residential quarters for the Government Employees.

b. Issue direction, order or writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to hand over possession of entire land of Bapa Nagar, New Delhi for infrastructural needs for expansion of Hon'ble Delhi High Court including Delhi High Court Bar Association, by relocating the existing occupants of the residential quarters in Bapa Nagar, New Delhi, to the newly constructed / under constructed, in any of GPRA Scheme of construction of flats, as referred to para 15 of the writ petition.

c. Pass any such other and further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case."

2. Looking at the prayers made in the writ petition, this Court is of the opinion that present matter must be listed before Division Bench-I.
3. Subject to the Orders of Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice, list the present matter before Division Bench-I on 01.05.2024.
