This is with reference to Show cause notice issued vide this office order no. AO/RPC/MCD/2024/D-2740 dated 16.01.2025 in respect of subject cited parking site wherein three days time be given to submit reply in the matter. However, no satisfactory reply in this regard received from your side till date.

In view of above:-

- i. The offer letter no. AC/RPC/MCD/2024/D-2598 dated 31.12.2024 of subject parking site stands withdrawn with immediate effect.
- ii. You/your firm are therefore debarred for a period of three years for participating in the tenders of MCD.
- iii. EMD amount of Rs.16,84,532/- deposited in the parking site has been forfeited.

3. He states that *issue no. (ii)* and *(iii)* have been decided and *issue no. (i)* with respect to offer relating to parking site is still in abeyance.

4. Accordingly, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (**'MCD'**) shall take a decision in this regard, considering the order by the Division Bench of this Court on 08th April 2025, which is as under:

4. This petition is thus disposed of in terms of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the learned counsel for the MCD. We further provide that till a fresh decision under this order is taken by the MCD, the decision which is under challenge herein shall be kept in abeyance so far as it relates to blacklisting of the petitioner and forfeiture of the EMD amount. We also make it clear that it would be open to the petitioner to take up all the pleas and grounds available to it under law when the entire matter is revisited by the MCD and for the said purpose it shall be permitted to make a representation within a week.

5. In the event, hearing is sought by petitioner, they can issue a written communication to respondent with copy to counsel for respondent in this regard.
