1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks to assail the order dated 29.02.2024 passed by Ld. CMM, West District, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi in C.C. No. 12280/2016.
2. Mr. Aggarwal, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner states that at the stage of summoning, summons were issued by designation and not by



name. It is submitted that initially only Editor-in-Chief of Dainik Punjab Kesari, Delhi Edition was summoned. It is only after 24 years that the petitioner, who is now aged about 94 years old, has been summoned by the Trial Court.

3. Issue notice.
4. Ld. APP for State accepts notice for respondent No.1.
5. On petitioner taking steps, let the notice be issued to respondent No.2 through all permissible modes.
6. Renotify on 08.10.2024.
7. In the meantime, the petitioner is exempted from personal appearance before the Trial Court.
