1. By way of present application, the appellant seeks interim suspension of her sentence on the ground that her daughter is in family way and expected date of her delivery is around 19.09.2025.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that applicant's son-in-law has to often travel outside Delhi for work. He further submits that the attending doctor has advised family support and care at the time of delivery.
3. A Verification Report has been handed over in Court which is taken on record as per which, factum of appellant's daughter being in family way is verified to be correct. The treating doctor has also been examined who has confirmed the said fact. Appellant's nominal roll dated 30.08.2025 is on record as per which she has undergone 3 years, 7 months and 29 days alongwith remission of 3 months and 24 days and her unexpired portion is 3 years and 7 days.



4. Considering the verification report as well as the nominal roll, it is directed that the applicant's sentence shall remain suspended for a period of six weeks from the date of her release, subject to her furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Judicial Magistrate/Link Judicial Magistrate/Jail Superintendent and also subject to the further following conditions:-

- i) The applicant shall provide her mobile number to the Investigating Officer, which she undertakes to keep operational at all times during the period of her release;
- ii) The applicant shall not directly/indirectly try to get in touch with the prosecution witnesses or tamper with the evidence;
- iii) The applicant shall surrender after the expiry of the interim bail period.

5. Application is disposed of in the above terms.

6. A copy of this order be communicated electronically to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
