CRL.M.(BAIL) 737/2024 (for suspension of sentence)

Present application has been filed seeking suspension of sentence.

The petitioner was convicted by the court of learned M.M. for the offence under Section 356/379 IPC and was sentenced for a period of two years for offence under Section 356 IPC and imprisonment of three years for the offence under Section 379 IPC. Learned M.M. also directed that both the sentences shall run concurrently.

An appeal being Crl.Appeal No.558/2023 filed against the order of learned M.M. was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge vide judgment dated 06.03.2024.

The present revision petition has been filed challenging the impugned judgment dated 06.03.2024 passed by learned ASJ, South West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi. Since the petitioner has been convicted for RI



for two years under Section 356 IPC and for three years for the offence under Section 379 IPC which are directed to run concurrently, the sentence of the petitioner is suspended during the pendency of the present petition. The applicant is admitted to court bail upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioner shall remain available on his mobile number which he undertakes to keep operational during the pendency of the present appeal.
- (ii) The petitioner shall further remain in touch telephonically with police officer in-charge on his mobile number on the first Monday of every month.
- (iii) The petitioner shall regularly appear before the Court as and when the petition is taken up for hearing and shall not leave the country without the permission of the learned Trial Court.
- (iv) In the event of a change of his permanent residential address/ contact details, the appellant shall promptly inform the same to the concerned police officer in-charge and the court.

The application stands disposed of.
