1. The present application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking amendment of the plaint as enumerated in para 2 of the application.
2. Learned counsel for the defendant submits that he has no objection as to the amendment sought at Serial Nos. 1 and 2 of the tabulated chart in para 2 of the application. He submits that the only objection is regarding the amendment sought at Serial No. 3 of the tabulated chart inasmuch as word "Delhi" is being inserted for the purpose of getting territorial jurisdiction of this Court.
