1. Learned arguing counsel for the respondents is stated to be held up



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before the learned Central Administrative Tribunal and therefore, a pass over is sought. However taking in view the Board position a pass over is not feasible at this stage. We, therefore, have no other option but to defer hearing.

2. Since we are deferring the hearing on account of Ms. Chatterjee being held up before the learned Tribunal from where she has tried to join the Court proceeding virtually but, is not clearly audible, we are granting both sides time to file written submissions, if not already filed, within a period of four weeks.

3. Taking into account the order passed by the Apex Court, we make it clear that though we are granting liberty to the parties to file written submissions, the matter will not be adjourned on the next date of hearing for want of written submissions.
