CONT.CAS(C) 671/2025

1. This petition alleges wilful disobedience of judgment dated 29th November 2024 passed by this Court in ***W.P.(C) 5741/2017***, where the following directions were passed:

23. For all the aforesaid reasons, this Court is unable to uphold the impugned judgment dated 18.05.2017 passed by the DST in Appeal No.65/2014 as also the penalty of compulsory retirement. Accordingly, writ petition is allowed quashing and setting aside the judgment of the DST as well as the charge memo, inquiry proceedings and the penalty order. Petitioner has reached the age of superannuation on 30.09.2015, during the pendency of this writ petition and therefore, it is directed that he be granted notional reinstatement with all consequential retiral benefits.

2. Counsel for petitioner states that compliance of this order has still not



been done.

3. Issue notice.
4. Counsel for respondent no.1, who appears through VC, accepts notice.
5. Considering that the order was passed in November 2024 and the petitioner is 70 years of age, respondent is expected to take expeditious action in this regard.

7. In the event compliance is not made prior to the next date, concerned officer from respondent no.1 shall remain present before the Court, either physically or *through VC*.
