1. *Vide* order dated 19.02.2026, it was recorded as under:-

1. The petitioner, who appears in persons, submits that directions contained in the judgment dated 29.11.2024 passed in W.P(C) 5741/2017 has not been complied with.
2. In the circumstance, the concerned Deputy Director, Directorate of Education (DOE), GNCTD is directed to carry out an interactive exercise with the petitioner for calculating/ recalculating the financial benefits to which the petitioner is entitled for in terms of the judgment dated 29.11.2024. Let the said interaction be carried out on 26.02.2026 at 11.00 AM.
3. All the concerns / deficiencies highlighted by the petitioner shall be duly considered and the amount / benefits payable to the petitioner shall be worked out.
4. Let a fresh status report be filed by the respondent / Directorate of Education (DOE) within a period of four weeks from today.



5. The concerned Deputy Director, DOE shall remain present in the Court on the next date of hearing.

6. List on 24.03.2026.

2. Learned counsel for the Directorate of Education (DOE) submits that the matter received urgent consideration of the concerned Deputy Director. It is submitted that the exercise contemplated in the aforesaid order dated 19.02.2026 is underway and shall be completed latest within a period of two weeks from today. The said undertaking is taken on record.

3. The concerned school is directed to supply necessary documents, as may be required for the aforesaid purpose, to the DOE, without delay. The copy of the documents as may be sought from the school shall also be supplied to the petitioner.

4. In case of any lapse/ omission or deficiency on the part of the concerned school, the same shall be construed as egregious and wilful disregard of the orders passed by this Court, entailing severe action against the Manager and other Senior Officials of the school under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

5. List for reporting compliance on 06.07.2026.

6. If compliance remains incomplete, the concerned Deputy Director, DOE and the Manager of the respondent no.2 (school) are directed to remain personally present in Court on the next date of hearing.
