ORDER

1. The learned APP for State submits that the charges have already been framed in the case and the matter is listed for Prosecution Evidence on 28.08.2025.
2. However, learned Counsel for the Petitioner who is appearing through



Video Conferencing insists that neither any Charges have been framed nor the matter has been fixed for Prosecution Evidence. Rather the FIR has been quashed qua the co-accused in the light of the judgment of the Madras High Court and the present case is nothing but an abuse of the process of the Court and is liable to be quashed.

3. Despite specific query about framing of Charge, the learned Counsel is insisting that it is a fit case for quashing.
4. After some arguments learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks time to appear in person in the Court and also to verify the status of the trial in the Court of learned M.M and also to confirm whether the Petitioner has been appearing and facing the trial before the learned Trial Court.
5. Written submissions be filed by both the parties within ten days.
6. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that he shall appear in person on the next date of hearing to argue the matter.
