Mr. Vaibhav Venkatas, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits, that on point of fact that the entire amount due to respondent No.2 stands duly paid; and since the matters were essentially of a civil nature, nothing survives in terms of the criminality.

In the circumstances, Mr. Venkatash submits, that the Investigating Officer may be directed to verify the documents appended to the petitions to verify whether the amounts in dispute stands paid or not.

It is also submitted that a quashing petition filed by the co-accused has already been allowed by Co-ordinate Bench of this court *vide* order dated 22.01.2019 in CRL.M.C. No.323/2019.
