1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application is disposed of.

**W.P.(C) 5622/2025 & CM APPL. 25611/2025 (Stay)**

3. The present petition has been filed seeking directions to respondent no.1 to take immediate and necessary steps to demolish the unauthorized and illegal construction being carried out by respondent no. 9 on the forest land situated at *Gali No. D-41, Chhatarpur Pahari, 100 Feet Road, New Delhi*. And, further to direct respondent no. 5 to restore the said forest area.
4. Issue Notice. Notice is accepted by the learned counsels for the respondent nos. 1 to 8.
5. Issue Notice to the respondent no. 9 by all modes, including through speed post upon filing of the requisite process fee.
6. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no. 3, i.e., the Central Vigilance Commission (“CVC”), submits that it has no role in the present petition and, therefore, it ought to be deleted.
7. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instruction, submits that he has no objection to the deletion of the respondent no. 3 from the array of parties.
8. Accordingly, the respondent no. 3 is deleted from the array of parties.
9. Let the Amended Memo of Parties be filed within a period of one week from today.
10. Let Status Report/replies be filed by respondents within a period of four weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed, within a period of two weeks, thereafter.
11. The concerned authorities are directed to ensure that no unauthorized



construction or encroachment is carried out in the aforesaid forest area, in terms of the submissions, as recorded herein above.

12. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner is directed to serve a copy of present petition to the respondents on the Emails, which are reflected in today's order.

13. The concerned authorities are further directed to ensure that no deforestation takes place in the said forest area.

14. Re-notify on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2025.
