1. This application has been filed on behalf of appellant/claimant seeking specific directions for the medical examination of appellant/claimant.
2. Appellant/Claimant suffered injuries in an accident on 13th January 2019 and pursuant to filing a claim, impugned award dated 12th September 2024 awarding compensation was passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal [**‘MACT’**] South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, against which this appeal has been filed.
3. Before the MACT, appellant/claimant could not obtain a Disability Certificate due to the onset of Covid pandemic.
4. An earlier application being **CM APPL. 26234/2025** was moved seeking a similar direction; by order dated 01st May 2025, the Court granted liberty to appellant/claimant to take appropriate steps to obtain the Permanent Disability Certificate.
5. *Mr. Manish Maini*, counsel for appellant/claimant states that the



claimant is a permanent resident of *Muzaffarpur, Bihar* and could not obtain the Permanent Disability Certificate, since he is a non-resident of Delhi and, therefore, specific directions in that regard are required.

6. In view of the submissions made and reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.

7. *Medical Superintendent, Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hospital, Hari Nagar, New Delhi-110064* is directed to constitute a Medical Board to assess the permanent disability of appellant/claimant within three weeks from today and submit a report to this Court, within three weeks thereafter.

8. A copy of this order be sent to the *Medical Superintendent, Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hospital, Hari Nagar, New Delhi-110064*.

9. Copy of the order be given 'dasti' under the signatures of the Court Master.

10. Application stands disposed of, accordingly.
