The hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode (physical and virtual hearing).

CM APPL. 45811/2022 (by R-4 for clarification/modification of order dt. 30.08.2022)

1. This application seeks modification of a typographical error in the order dated 30.08.2022 insofar as in para 6 thereof it records that 'R-1 undertakes to issue public notices within two weeks of the order'.



R-1 is the Union of India, no such undertaking was to be or was given on behalf of the UOI. Therefore, in the said para, 'R-1' should be read as the 'petitioner-company'. The learned counsel for the non-applicants submit that the relief sought be granted. Accordingly, para 6 shall be read as:

"6. Albeit notices are stated to have been put up on the Notice Board of the petitioner-company and the workmen are free to approach the office for the settlement of their individual claims, petitioner-company undertakes to issue public notices within two weeks of this order to the effect that workmen should approach the office of the petitioner for the settlement of their individual claims...."

2. The court is informed notice has already been put-up in the Corporate Office of the petitioner and the workmen are stated to be approaching the company for settlement. As regards the public notice, Mr. M.A. Niyazi, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the relevant publication shall be issued on or before 25.10.2022 in two newspapers: one in Hindi and the other in English.
3. The application is disposed-off in terms of the above.
