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The hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode (physical and virtual hearing).

1. In terms of the order dated 30.08.2022, the respondent nos.10 and 11 were to approach the petitioner apropos their members affiliated to their respective Unions. They have not done so. An advertisement has been published by the petitioner on 24.10.2022 in Dainik Jagran Newspaper in Hindi and Indian Express Newspaper in English. Thus for only four workmen have contacted the petitioner claiming relief in terms of the BIFR Sanctioned Scheme of June, 2004 and not in 2000 as erroneously typed in the order dated 30.08.2022.
2. The learned counsel for the respondent nos.10 and 11 assure the court that the said Unions and its members shall approach the court within a period of four weeks from today.
3. Respondent nos.10 and 11 shall approach the petitioner on 08.12.2022 at 11:00 a.m. and shall submit all relevant documents within a month from today.
4. The learned counsel for the said respondents submit that every endeavour shall be made to find closure to the pending *lis*.
5. The interim order dated 21.07.2022 shall continue.
6. The learned counsel for the respondent nos.5 and 6 reiterates support to the Scheme.
