CRL.M. (BAIL) 50/2022

1. Ms. Sonia Mathur, learned Senior Counsel for the appellant, on instructions, submits that the necessary clinical evaluation of the appellant could not be done for want of appointment. She further submits that the appellant is unable to open his mouth beyond a certain point and requires to undergo physiotherapy session twice a day. She submits that the appellant is not having frontal tooth due to which he is unable to intake any solid food. She has referred to the order dated 18.11.2021 passed by this Court, on which date *Dr. Charan, SMO, Tihar Jail-03, Delhi* had joined the proceedings through V.C. and stated that though liquid/semi-solid diet food



can be provided in the jail however providing necessary physiotherapy may not be possible, as the physiotherapist visits only once/twice a week.

2. Today, *Dr. Purshottam, SMO, Tihar Jail-03, Delhi* has joined the proceedings through V.C. and reiterates that the physiotherapist visits the jail only twice a week.

3. At this stage, it is deemed apposite that the appellant be also reviewed by the *SMO, Tihar Jail-03, Delhi* in order to enable him to take an informed decision on the present medical condition of the appellant.

4. Learned Senior Counsel for the appellant, on instructions, submits that the appellant shall appear before the *SMO, Tihar Jail-03, Delhi* on 07.03.2022 at 10:00 a.m.

5. Accordingly, the concerned Jail Superintendent shall ensure that all necessary arrangements are made so that the appellant can be examined by the jail doctor on the aforementioned date and time.

6. Renotify on 16.03.2022.

7. Till the next date of hearing, interim orders to continue on the same terms and conditions.

8. Copy of the order be communicated electronically forthwith to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
