ORDER

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CRL.M.(BAIL) 1541/2024 (for extension of interim bail of applicant)

1. By way of the present application, the applicant/appellant seeks extension of interim bail granted to the appellant for a period of two months vide order dated 03.07.2024.
2. The application has been premised on the ground that the applicant is suffering from oral cancer and the application is also accompanied by the medical documents.
3. Learned senior counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant's sentence has been suspended from time to time. He further submits that the applicant is undergoing regular treatment at various hospitals including at AIIMS.



4. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that a verification report has been placed on record. He further states that the medical documents stand verified.
5. Considering that the medical documents already stand verified and that the applicant has been repeatedly released on interim bail, a concession of which he has not misused, the interim bail granted to the applicant is extended till the next date of hearing i.e. 18.02.2025 on the same terms and conditions as contained in the order dated 03.07.2024.
6. The application is disposed of in the above terms.
7. A copy of this order be communicated electronically to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
8. Copy of the order be also uploaded on the website forthwith.

CRL.M.A. 28802/2024 (for release of original FDRs on behalf of the applicants)

1. The present application has been preferred by the applicants seeking release of the FDRs furnished by the applicants at the time of interim suspension of sentence of the appellant.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has furnished bail bonds before the Trial Court and at that time furnished separate FDRs on which endorsement has been made by the Trial Court. He submits that the initial FDRs which were furnished before this Court as surety in terms of the order dated 02.06.2023 granting bail to the appellant has already been replaced by other FDRs containing the endorsement and, therefore prays that the present FDRs be released.
3. Learned SPP appearing for the respondent, on instructions, submits that he has no objection to the prayer made in the present application.



4. Accordingly, the application is allowed.
5. In view of the above, it is directed that the endorsement on the FDRs stands cancelled and the original FDRs which are on record in CRL. Appeal No. 451/2020 be released to the applicant.
6. Consequently, the application stands disposed of.
