3. This is an application filed under Section 430(1) of BNSS, 2023 seeking suspension of sentence during the pendency of the present criminal appeal.

Crl. M. (Bail) 317/2025 (suspension of sentence for period of 4 months)

7. The present application has been under Section 430 BNSS seeking interim suspension of sentence for a period of four months.

8. Mr. Ajay Burman, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant/applicant submits that earlier this Court had granted interim bail to the appellant *vide* order dated 18.11.2024 in Crl. M (Bail) 1541/2024 till 18.02.2025 on the ground that the applicant is suffering from oral cancer and he needs treatment.

9. He submits that currently the applicant is undergoing treatment at Oncology Department as well as Dental Department of AIIMS and also at a Govt. hospital, Kanpur. He, therefore, urges that the interim bail of the appellant be extended till regular bail is heard by this Court.

10. Issue notice. Learned SPP appearing on behalf of the respondent-CBI accepts notice.

11. Let status report be filed before the next date.

12. Renotify on 11.03.2025.

13. In the meanwhile, the interim bail granted to the applicant *vide* order dated 18.11.2024 is extended till the next date on the same terms and conditions as mentioned in the order dated 18.11.2024.
