1. Pursuant to orders of the Hon'ble Court dated 12.11.2020, whereby the appellant has been allowed to be released on interim bail for a period of 8 weeks from the date of his release, surety Ranjana and Parmal Singh (cousin of the appellant) have joined the proceedings today through EVL and they have been identified by their counsel. They have furnished personal bond and surety bonds in compliance of the aforesaid order in the Court today. They have furnished three FDRs, one FDR for Rs.1 lac and two FDRs of Rs.50,000/- each, in compliance of the aforesaid orders. The same are endorsed and returned.
2. Copy of their Aadhaar Cards (OSR) are taken on record.
3. The personal bond and surety bonds are found in order and are hereby accepted provisionally till the next date of hearing. In the meantime the concerned SP/ DSP, CBI shall verify the contents of the



same and submit verification report before this court on 5th December, 2020. Learned counsel for the appellant undertakes to file originals of the personal and surety bonds in physical form in the Registry today itself.

4. Requisite endorsement has been made on the FDRs issued by the concerned bank. (Original seen and returned). An intimation be sent to the Bank Manager of the concerned bank informing the factum of the above endorsement having been made on the FDRs, tendered as security in this case and that the said FDRs shall not be encashed or kept as security elsewhere till further orders of this Court. The sureties are also directed to keep the FDRs in question alive during the period of interim bail.
5. The appellant is also directed to inform this Court as and when he changes his address as mentioned in the personal bond now furnished by way of an affidavit.
6. Copy of this order be sent to concerned jail authorities alongwith the release warrant. The appellant is directed to surrender before the jail superintendent concerned immediately on expiry of period of interim bail.
