1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present two writ petitions relate to the pharmaceutical preparation 'DAPAGLIFLOZIN', for which the Petitioner is stated to be holding Indian Patent No. IN 235625. It is submitted that there are 13 suits which are pending in respect of this very patent before the Bench of Hon'ble Ms. Justice Jyoti Singh.
3. One of the Defendants in the said suit is also Torrent Pharmaceuticals Limited which is the Petitioner in ***W.P.(C)-IPD 25/2021*** and Respondent No.3 in ***W.P.(C)-IPD 24/2021***. Mr. Majumdar, Id. Counsel for Torrent Pharmaceuticals Limited, submits that the present writ petitions can be heard, despite the pendency of the Special Leave Petition before the Supreme Court. Let the said submission be made before the concerned Bench.

Considering that the interim injunction applications have already been decided in these matters and the issues raised in these matters are stated to be now pending before the Supreme Court in respect of this very patent, it is deemed appropriate that these two writ petitions are also listed before the same Bench.
