1. Arguments heard in part. Decree holder, judgment debtor no. 1 and judgment debtor no. 2 have concluded their submissions.
2. The parties are directed to file their written submissions not exceeding three (3) pages. The chronology of event referred to by judgment debtor no. 2 during arguments shall be filed separately with the written submissions.
3. Decree holder, judgment debtor no. 1, judgment debtor no. 2 in their respective written submissions, will take a categorical stand with respect to the compliance of the condition in the decree requiring prior permission of the High Court in the criminal proceedings for executing the sale deed. In



case either party takes a stand that the said permission in the criminal proceedings is not required, the date on which the said status came into existence will be specifically identified and the date mentioned in the written submission.

4. Judgment debtor nos. 3 and 4 are also at liberty to file written submission on the same terms as above.

5. To come up for arguments of judgment debtor nos. 3 and 4 on **09.01.2025**.
